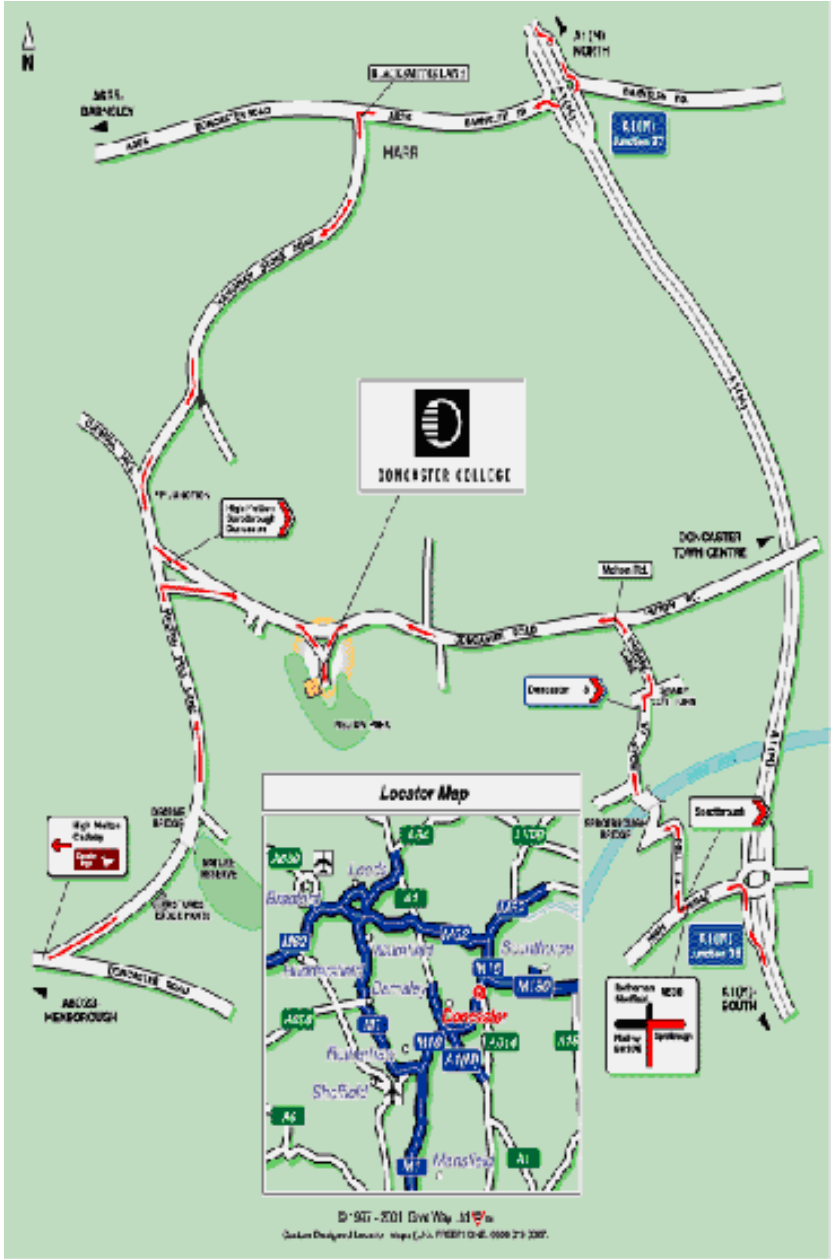

## University Centre, Doncaster

Officially inaugurated on 12 August 2004, the University Centre is the first step towards the realisation of Doncaster's goal, within the Doncaster Education City (DEC) project, of having its own University of Doncaster early in the next decade. It is the latest exciting feature in a programme of development and expansion that has secured a prominent place for Doncaster in education development nationally.

The University Centre builds on Doncaster College's existing record of higher education success, enabling it to offer an even broader range of high quality opportunities, with programmes and courses from NVQ Level 4 to PhD level, tailored to the contemporary needs of both students and employers.

### What does this mean?

The designation officially recognises the range of degree-level provision already offered by Doncaster College - and will pave the way for the creation of new higher education programmes with support from and validated by the University of Hull.

## Accommodation

Accommodation is available in single study bedrooms in halls of residence. There are kitchens available with tea/coffee making facilities. A night's accommodation is available at a charge (to be paid for upon arrival) for room and continental breakfast, which will be served in Deans Lodge. ## Healthy Eating

## How to find us

By Road from Doncaster. Leave on the Great North Road, A638, pass under railway bridge, take first turn left at traffic lights follow road through Sprotborough to High Melton for about 4 miles.

By Road from the North. Follow the A1 then A1M leaving at junction 37 towards Barnsley, A635. Turn left opposite Marr Country Club (Blacksmiths Lane) At the T junction turn left into High Melton, the college is on the right hand side.

By road from the South. M1, turn off on to M18 for Doncaster, to Doncaster bypass A1M, leaving at junction 37, A635, and then follow as from the North.

Public Transport. Bus Nos 74 & 149 are approximately every 30 mins from Doncaster and Mexborough. The bus stations are close to the railway stations. For up to date information please telephone 01709 589200.
